Years 12 & Year 13 - Non-Uniform Day – Jeans for Genes – Tuesday 21 October 2025

On Tuesday 21 October 2025, the 6th Form Senior Team will be holding a non-uniform day for all students in Years 12 and 13 to raise money for both 'Jeans for Genes' charity and to help support the Year 13 Prom. The money raised will be divided equally between both causes. Jeans for Genes, a campaign run by Genetic Disorders UK, raises money and awareness for children with genetic disorders. The funds raised support vital research into genetic conditions and provide essential care and support services for affected individuals and their families.

Ideally, students should wear jeans for this charity fundraising event. However, there is no compulsion to take part in this non-uniform day, and students will be able to wear their school uniform if they wish. However, if they choose not to wear uniform, a voluntary donation of £2 can be made via ParentPay.
