## **Year 11 – MET Future Destinations Fair – Friday 21 November 2025**

Year 11 students are being given the opportunity to take part in the Future Destinations Fair on Friday 21 November. As part of our Careers Education strategy, we have arranged for students to have direct access to post-16 and post-18 guidance, support and information to help them to think through the different options available to them in their journey to their future destination.

To support students in Year 11, we have invited local further education colleges and also student representatives from Maiden Erlegh 6th Form so that students can gain the relevant information so that they feel fully informed about making appropriate decisions for life after Year 11. Students will also have access to universities, and apprenticeship specialists if they wish during their allocated time.

Students in 11M English option should go to their period 3 lesson to be registered, after which they will be able to visit the fair from 11.25am to 11.55am. They will then return to the rest of their timetabled lesson.

Students in 11E English option should go to their period 5 lesson to be registered, where they will then undertake their lesson for 30 minutes and then come and join the fair from 2.30pm to 3pm. Students will be able to leave school at 3pm, at the normal time.
