Individual Learning Plan (ILP) Fortnight – Monday 18 May to Thursday 21 May & Monday 1 June to Thursday 4 June

Next week, Year 12 students will be completing their ILP (Individual Learning Plan) document during their morning tutor sessions. This is an opportunity for students to reflect on their recent DCP (Data Collection Point) and prelim grades, identify their strengths, and set themselves SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, Time-limited) targets to help support their progress in each of their subjects.

During the weeks commencing Monday 18 May and Monday 1 June (allowing for half term), all Year 12 students will have a short one-to-one ILP meeting with their tutor to review their targets and progress. This will provide students with a valuable opportunity to develop their oracy skills, confidently discussing their many strengths, and to identify their next steps. These are important skills for their progress at Key Stage 5 and models the reflective conversations held within a workplace environment.

To facilitate these meetings, while ILP meetings are being held students are not required to register with their tutor in the mornings from Monday to Thursday. Instead, they should register in the Sixth Form Common Room at 8.30am every morning. For ILP fortnight, all lessons and supervised study sessions must be attended as normal, according to the student's timetable. The school day remains as normal on a Friday, where students should attend assembly at 8.30am, followed by their timetabled lessons.

Students can access their reports via the Student App, in much the same way that you can access reports via the MyChildAtSchool App. They are also available via email. Many students have received some or all of their Prelim results already. However, a copy of the results will be emailed home on Friday 15 May. If you or your child have any difficulties accessing their report, please request support via mesmcas@maidenerleghtrust.org.
